

Questions –

**1. We counted 9 suited positions in the Tower – is that about right?**

- There are 17 positions located in the Tower (including the elevators). Depending on attendance in the club, this number can rise to a total of 20 positions.

**2. Are golf carts / mules provided for the vendor? If so, how many?**

- A total of 12 golf carts are provided for the vendor on game days. This number can vary based on attendance.

**3. Is the awarded supplier allowed to use its own cart?**

- Yes

**4. Are there any compensation requirements other than minimum wage? Is the federal living wage a minimum standard?**

- There are no compensation requirements other than minimum wage. We have previously confirmed with the State Department of Labor that these positions are not subject to the State's Standard Wage Rate.

**5. The Appropriations Committee approved allowing a substantial increase to the present min wage. The bill would raise the state minimum hourly wage from \$10.10 to \$13.50 on Jan. 1, 2020; and from \$13.50 to \$15 on Jan. 1, 2021. Once the minimum wage reaches \$15 in 2022, the bill pegs any increases to the consumer price index. The bill seems stalled at present. Section 4 requires a three year pricing offer. How should the respondents treat the potential of a significant increase in the min wage.?**

- Given the uncertainty of a minimum wage increase, bidders should propose whatever wage rates and annual increases they feel are appropriate.

**6. What are the present bill rates?**

- The stadium will not be releasing current bill rates.
